Honored guests at the tourney were Sir Richard Ironsteed, the King of Atenveldt, and Sir Frederic of the West Tower, Baron Three Mountains.

Frederick of Holland was awarded the Bone of Fafnir by King Jean to speed the recovery of a broken bone in one hand which kept him from fighting. The King charged Frederick to give the bone to any other fighters who might need it in the future. (The bone in Frederick's hand was broken at Sir Caradoc's Saint David's Day tourney at Tilden's Amphitheater Playfield.) Frederick of Holland was also complimented by the King for his work as tourney master and for setting up the field.

Fighting began with three demonstration matches of met and trident, used by Charles of the JAC's, against gladius and small shield, used by Raynard the Fox. Charles won the first and third matches; Raynard won the second.

Two melees were held, with about eighteen men per side, one side led by Duke Henrik of Havn and one side led by Sir Frederic of the West Tower. Duke Henrik's side won both melees.

Challenge matches were fought next, with each man limited to one fight before the crown lists.

In the left-hand field, the following matches were fought. (Greencloak Herald was heralding):

1. Duke Richard, using a maul, challenged Sir Jon the Lean, using a flail, because Jon the Lean tends to flail around at the best of times. Duke Richard won.
2. James Grayhelm challenged Arthur of Pretense because he took offense at the grossness of Arthur's blazon (potent, a cock rising). James won.
3. Eliazar ben Dovid challenged Waren the Strange. Waren won by disarming Eliazar.
4. Sir Ardral Argo verKaeyse challenged Kevin a'Perigryne to celebrate Sir Ardral's return to the field. Kevin won.
5. Sir Caradoc challenged William of York, because William claimed the white rose is Yorkist and Caradoc claimed it is Stewart. William won.
6. Sir Thumas challenged Duke Henrik. Duke Henrik won.
7. Christian of Orange challenged Sir Stefan de Lorraine. Christian won.
