There was one challenge held in May 1972 that had been postponed from an earlier tourney. Lady Rima of Rockridge had challenged Sir Caradoc ap Cador to epigrams at twenty paces, for the joy of poetry. In May, this challenge match was held at the request of King James. Since Sir Caradoc refused to write any poetry, Lady Rima wrote both sides. She was kind neither to Sir Caradoc nor to herself. She has promised copies to the Lists, but they have not yet been received.

More conventional challenge matches ensued.

1. Sir Stephen MacEanruig challenged Sir Paul of Bellatrix as a celebration of Sir Paul's freedom to fight at tournaments. (Winner not recorded.)
2. Sir Thumas O'Conaire challenged Master Edwin Berserk to determine who will give an unqualified fighter some practice. Master Edwin was victorious.

(Irreverent footnote: Did the winner or the loser have to provide the practice?)
(Or was the fight itself the practice?) (Who was unqualified?)

3. Raymond the Mild challenged Hal von Ravn because of Hal's uninspired challenge to Raymond at the last tourney. Raymond won.
4. Raymond the Mild challenged Sir Paul of Bellatrix to congratulate Sir Paul on his successful reign. Sir Paul won.
5. Johanna von Griffenhurst, Joan of the Sea Keep, and Geraldine of Toad Hall issued this challenge: We do hereby defy any other three persons to lose more combined weight than they, starting Monday, May 8, and ending with the June tourney, June 17. The losing team shall each have to write a letter to Count Marco telling him how wonderful he is and how they have respected him for years, said letters to be read aloud before the populace. The letters must be signed.

This challenge was never taken up to the knowledge of the Lists.

6. Gilles of Lennox challenged Sir Steven MacEanruig to prove whether Sir Steven's Scale is any good. Gilles of Lennox won.
(Did Steven improve his scale?)
7. Raymond the Mild challenged Edgar the Unready because Edgar is attempting to frighten off the ladies with his device. Raymond won.
8. Bern Bellow challenged Sir Steven MacEanruig for the thrill of death. Bern won.
(I thought this wasn't supposed to be for real.)
9. Sir Thomas of the Pines challenged William of Hoghton to test Sir Thomas's new, heavy, unwieldy sword. Sir Thomas won.
(Not that unwieldy, I suppose.)
10. Master Edwin Berserk challenged Master Frederick of Holland because he seldom gets a chance to fight a Master. Master Edwin emerged the winner.
11. Raymond the Mild challenged Master Frederick of Holland because Master Frederick failed the challenge Raymond, to defend a member of Master Frederick's household* when Raymond licked her nose. Raymond won.
(No doubt lady Elizabeth.)
12. Bern Bellow challenged William the Lucky because the sun is shining. William won.
13. Sir Thomas of the Pines challenged Edgar the Unready to test the clumsy thing further. Sir Thomas won again.

14. William of Hoghton challenged Gillis of Lennox because William is allergic to cats. Gillis won.
15. Rematch, on the grounds that the first fight was too short. William won.
16. Pierre Lyon Goules challenged Edgar the Unready because Pierre's lady is afraid of mice. Edgar the Unready won. (Pierre needs a mousetrap?)
17. William the Lucky challenged Raymond the Mild because he still doesn't think Raymond is very mild. Raymond won. (William is probably right.)
18. Bern Bellower challenged William of Hoghton because the wind is blowing. William won.
19. Raymond the Mild challenged Sir Steven MacEanruig because he was unaware of Sir Steven's real name.* Sir Steven won.
(*MacEarwig?)
20. Ranulf of the North Country challenged Raymond the Mild to test Ranulf's new sword. Raymond won.
21. William the Lucky challenged Master Frederick of Holland in the hopes that he may be more lucky against Master Frederick today than he was yesterday. Master Frederick won.
22. Cormac na Connacht challenged Sir Thomas of the Pines to test Cormac's shield. Sir Thomas won.
23. William the Lucky challenged William of Hoghton because he wishes to tower over the towers. William of Hoghton won.
24. William of Hoghton challenged Lord William the Lucky, hoping he isn't. Double kill.
25. Master Frederick of Holland challenged Sir Thomas of the Pines to see if Sir Thomas is still as fast after two months' absence. Sir Thomas won.
26. Raymond the Mild challenged Pierre Lyon Goules for the glory of combat. Pierre won.
27. William of Hoghton challenged Sir Steven of the Ashenlands because he does not approve of his scorched earth policy. William won.
28. Master Edwin Berserk challenged Sir Charles of Mercury because he has not yet challenged him as a knight. Sir Charles won.
29. Rematch. Charles won again.

DEFENDER OF THE ROYAL WARDS -- best two out of three matches

1. Sir Steven MacEanruig vs. Paul of Blackchurch.
First fight ended in a double kill. This counted as two matches.
Paul of Blackchurch won the deciding round.
2. Sir Steven MacEanruig vs. Bern Bellower. Sir Steven won.
3. Paul of Blackchurch vs. Ulfgarth von Bergen. Paul won.

MELEES FOLLOWED.

1. Side I: Sir Thomas (captain), William the Lucky, Pierre Lyon Goules, Bern Bellower, Filles of Lennox, Bergen von Rauch, Ronald Talbot
Side II: Master Frederick (captain), Andrew of Riga, William of Hoghton, Cormac na Connacht, Edgar the Unready, Hal von Ravn.
The first time, Master Frederick's side won. For the second fight, Ulfgarth von Bergen was added to Master Frederick's side. Sir Thomas's side won.

INTERRUPTING the melees, Ulfgarth, ~~Edgar~~ William of Hoghton, Hal von Ravn, and Cormac abducted Janet of Ilwerlain. Ranulf, Peter, Edgar, Thomas, Bergen, Gilles, ~~Janet~~ and James rescued her. (Paul of Blackchurch was late. ?)
