King Andrew ended his reign with two knightings, Douglas Longshanks and Robert of Westmarch. Two new members were admitted into the Order of the Silver Molet (also known as the Order of Chandos) which was instituted at Twelfth Night by King Henrik, as a new order of Knighthood, reserved for those who had been Knights for several years and exemplified all the knightly virtues, most particularly those of chivalry and service. At that time, Sir Robert of Dunbarrow and Sir Bela of Eastmarch were made the first members of the order. At this tournament, that they might serve in the honour guard at the Coronation of King William, Sir Stefan de Lorraine and Sir Kevin Perigrinne were admitted to the order, just previous to the coronation.

The initial rounds of the competition were conducted in four categories, (1. Sword and shield, 2. Impact weapons, 3. Short sword, and 4. Longsword.) with each fighter signed up in two of the four. Each category was conducted in straight elimination fights to produce a winner and a second place. In addition the losers of the semi-final rounds fought each other to ~~xxxxxx~~ decide a third and fourth place. In each category points were given to the first four places, four points for 1st. place, three points for second place, two points for third place, and one point for fourth place. The four fighters with the most points would proceed to the final competition each match to be fought two out of three, with each fighter selecting a weapon for one fight to be used by both fighters, and a third fight, if required, to be fought with any weapons, except that each fighter could not use that weapon he had selected in the first two fights but he could use the one selected for him by the other fighter.
